





Thank you for choosing our DVD/Receiver Shelf, this shelf was designed to be mounted on the wall. And then can put DVD or receivers on the glass shelves.












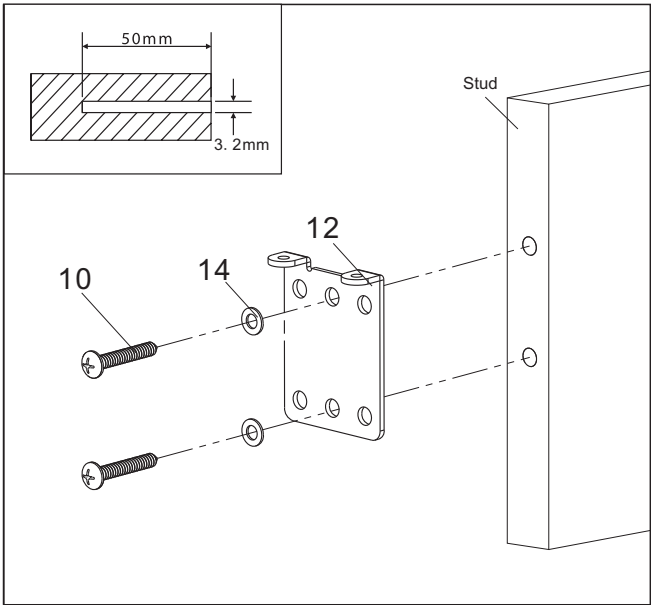
Step 1 Mounting the Wall Plate



Concrete Wall

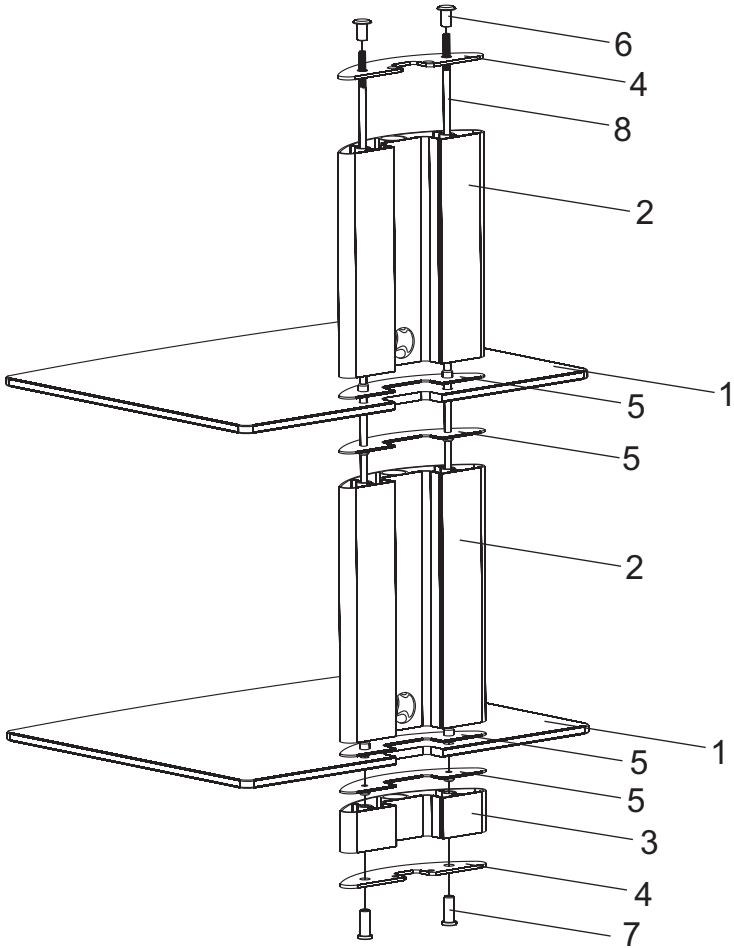


Dry Wall
